If you were a Georgia Citizen at all times from July 12, 2010 through October 6, 2017, had a deposit account with SunTrust Bank, and were charged an overdraft fee on certain transactions, you are eligible for a cash payment from a class action settlement.

Claim Form not included

Records show you may be eligible for a cash payment of \$_____ from a class action settlement with SunTrust Bank (“SunTrust”). If you qualify, the payment will be made as a single amount to the accountholders associated with your SunTrust Account. You must submit a valid Claim Form to receive your cash payment.

The case is *Bickerstaff v. SunTrust Bank*, No. 10EV010485, State Court of Fulton County. Plaintiffs alleged that certain of SunTrust’s overdraft fees constituted usury (illegal interest), conversion and “money had and received.”

SunTrust denies any wrongdoing, but the parties agreed to settle the lawsuit and make a cash payment available to members of the Class.

You were previously sent notice of the settlement, and the Court has now granted final approval. If you are a member of the Class, you can now submit a Claim Form to receive the payment associated with your account.

Records show you may be a Settlement Class Member, and, if so, that the amount above may be claimed on behalf of the accountholders associated with your SunTrust account.

To receive your payment, you must sign and return a claim form before September 14, 2026.

WHEN YOU SIGN AND SUBMIT THE CLAIM FORM, YOU WILL BE AFFIRMING UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY THAT YOU WERE A GEORGIA CITIZEN THROUGHOUT THE TIME PERIOD FROM JULY 12, 2010 THROUGH OCTOBER 6, 2017.

A “GEORGIA CITIZEN” IS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO, THROUGHOUT THE ABOVE TIME PERIOD, (I) WAS A U.S. CITIZEN AND (II) MADE GEORGIA THEIR HOME.
